What is the ACT with Writing?

The ACT is given 6 times during the year and tests a student's knowledge in four areas: English (45 minutes), Math (60 minutes), Reading (35 minutes) and Science Reasoning (35 minutes). A composite score is reported to colleges ranging from 1 to 36. There is no penalty for wrong answers in the scoring process, so answer every question.

An optional 30 minute writing test is available in 2005 and is required by the UC's to meet their admission standard.
